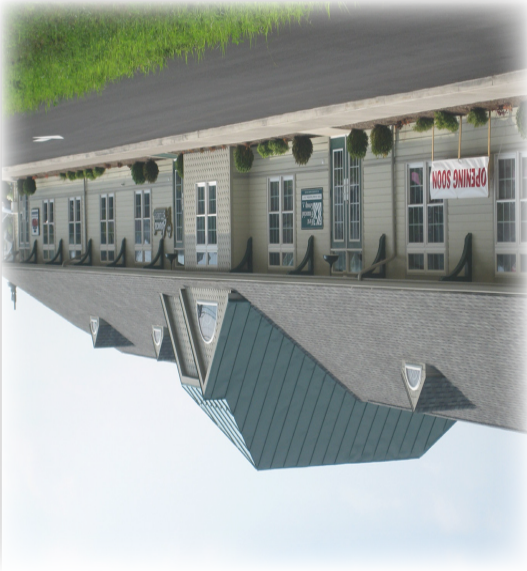

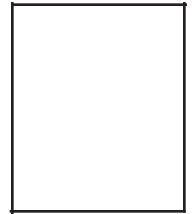

A new spacious one story new office building located in Milton, Pa, serving as the headquarters and regional office for a local foster care organization. Includes a metal roof, cultured stone siding, generous exterior porches, modern access control systems, and a geothermal heating/cooling system.

PROJECT DATE: 2006- Current

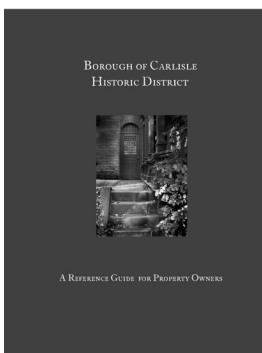
STATUS: Construction Fall 2007

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

A new 2 story office building to serve the foundation staff and community. The projects design allows for the first floor will be used by the foundation for their offices and conference rooms. The second floor will be leased space for one or two other organizations. The conference rooms are designed to allow community groups to use them after hours while not compromising building security. The building is being designed to achieve LEED Certification, at a minimum. Construction to start this fall.



Carlisle Historic District



A multi-Party funded Historical Guide Publication/Booklet with participation by the Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission, Borough of Carlisle, and the Carlisle Old Neighborhoods League. The goal was to produce a document to assist the Carlisle H.A.R.B. (Historical Architectural Review Board) Borough Council, citizens, and contractors in understanding the who, what, where, when, and how of the Carlisle H.A.R.B. process. We 'designed' the publication to be user-friendly while still containing the technical and procedural aspects needed. The document has been extremely well received and has already has a second printing and is the winner of the Preservation Pennsylvania 2007 Communications Award. 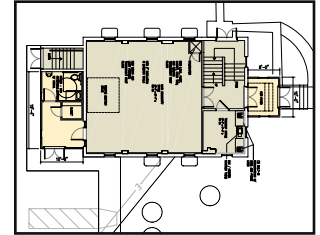
Scott Township Municipal Building

In 1992, we designed and built the Scott Township Municipal Building. This building was designed to house the Scott Township Police Department, the zoning office, and a public meeting room. The Scott Township Sewer Authority again hired us in 2005 to complete a 900 square foot addition which will include two offices, a multi-purpose room, and a file room. The addition was complete in March of 2007 and the staff wonders how they worked in the small in-efficient office, once shared by 4 and now only 2.



McHenry Township

- Renovation of an under used historic building.
- The building was formerly used as an Odd Fellows Hall & Church. When complete, the building will include Township administrative offices, Community Hall and emergency shelter spaces. The new addition will also house new accessible entrances & restrooms.
