Design of a new state of the art performance facility on an existing site in downtown Wellsboro. New facility to include main theater for approx. 350 with complete support spaces, prop room, scene shop, costume shop and dressing rooms. Separate black box theater also designed to share the back of house functions with the main stage.

The black box is designed to serve as a practice space separate from the main hall. The perimeter of the site proposed to provide retail spaces of flexible sizes in order to all leaseable tenant spaces to support the theater.

Existing Structures: The facades are to be preserved and smaller store fronts are to be provided. The back of those buildings will be removed for the new black box theater.
